



Lost 'n Found Student Ministry Chaperon Policy for Major & Minor Events and Activities

PURPOSE:

The goal of *Lost 'n Found Student Ministry* and Ascension Baptist Church is to set the best possible standard for our students and sponsors in how we operate our ministry and its calendared events each year. Therefore, we must take careful consideration in the process of who is allowed the privilege to accompany students on planned events throughout the year.

REQUIREMENTS:

Here are the minimum and maximum requirements.

A. One-day activities and minor events:

These events will have minimum restrictions.

1. Sponsor must to be a church member.
2. Sponsor must meet with the Associate Pastor or members of our Youth Committee, if necessary to participate in the planned function or event.
3. The sponsor must set a positive example to students and adults in character, speech, and attitude (1 Timothy 4:12).
4. Every person must adhere to & abide by the ABC Child Abuse & Molestation Policy.

B. Overnight or Out-of-Town Events:

These events carry more weight and therefore carry more restrictions.

1. Sponsor must be a church member.
2. Sponsor must meet with the Associate Pastor or members of our Youth Committee to participate in the planned function or event.
3. The sponsor must set a positive example to students and adults in character, speech, and attitude (1 Timothy 4:12).
4. Major events, such as mission trips, summer camps, and retreats requires the sponsor to participate in the majority of required fund raising, training, and service projects.
5. Some events will require extra emphasis on training and service, and these will have to be met by the sponsor in order to participate.
6. Every person must adhere to & abide by the ABC Child Abuse & Molestation Policy.
