



Lost 'n Found Student Ministry Dress Code Policy

BIBLICAL PRINCIPLE TO DETERMINE A DRESS CODE:

- The Conviction of Modesty (Ex. 28:42 & 1 Tim. 2:9)
- The Conviction of Distinction between the Sexes (Deut. 22:5).
- The Conviction of Avoiding Worldliness (Rom. 12:2).
- The Believer's Body is a Temple (1 Cor. 3:16)
- The Principle of Testimony (1 Cor. 10:31).

THE DRESS CODE: NON-NEGOTIABLE

1. No Spaghetti Straps, No Halter Tops, No Tank Tops, No low cut tops. No exposed midriff or see thru shirts (male or female). Sleeveless shirts may be worn except when specifically indicated not to. (Sleeveless meaning full coverage to the shoulder)
2. No Clothing with Distasteful slogans or Ads such as alcohol, tobacco, non-Christian logos or rock bands.
3. Shorts, skirts, and dresses must be modest in length. The length should be long enough that the bottom of the clothing at least touches the fingertips when they are extended.
4. Pants/Shorts should be worn with the waist around the waist. No low ride pants such that underwear will show.
5. Shorts should not be worn during Sunday morning or evening worship services shorts.
6. No tight fitting clothing as to draw attention to oneself from someone of the opposite sex.
7. Modest one piece bathing suits for all water activities.
8. The Youth Minister or Youth Leadership determines that an article of clothing or jewelry is distasteful, in respect to the ministry environment, that person should have the authority to initiate corrective action.

This is subject to change only at the Youth Committee's discretion.
